## BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING

**Soda Springs Water Company** is not approved by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Additionally, we don't have enough water quality data and/or our water system is not treated/disinfected adequately to ensure it is safe to drink.

### What does this mean? What should I do?

- ✓ **DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST.** Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for three (3) minutes, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation until further notice. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.
- ✓ This water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites, which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches. The symptoms above are not caused only by organisms in drinking water. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you may want to seek medical advice.
- ✓ People with severely compromised immune systems, infants, and some elderly may be at increased risk. These people should seek advice from their health care providers about drinking water.

### What happened? What is being done?

(Describe corrective action) On 4/11/19 at 1000 hrs the main water line was shut down in order to do repair work. The repairs are currently being finished. Bacteriological testing will be done to ensure water safety and you will be given written notice when the water is safe to drink.
